

## POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS APPS FOR CHILDREN

WHAT IS IT?	APP	CONCERNS
Houseparty Houseparty	Video-chat platform	- No screening of video content - Live video, inappropriate content - Chat function - Interaction with strangers
Tinder	Dating/connection platform	- Rated 17+ but allows 13+ to join - Geographic locations given - Interaction with strangers - High risk of catfishing, grooming, sexual harassment & stalking
CISK <i>fm</i> Ask.fm	Anonymous messaging service	- Cyberbullying - Threats - Sexual Content - Unmonitored access - Inconsistent age restrictions
<b>kik</b> • KIK Messenger	Instant messaging service	- Minimum age of 17, but no verification - Users can connect with strangers via usernames - Cyberbullying
Snapchat	Messaging service	- Users share time-limited images (not realising they can be screenshotted) - Sexting - Cyberbullying





## POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS APPS FOR CHILDREN

WHAT IS IT?	APP	CONCERNS
<b>J</b> Tik Tok	Video-sharing social networking service (such as videos).	<ul> <li>Minimum age of 13, but no verification</li> <li>All content is public by default</li> <li>Inappropriate language &amp; content</li> <li>Contact with strangers</li> </ul>
YouTube	Video-sharing platform	- Explicit comments on videos - Inappropriate content spliced into videos on the regular and kid's platforms - Known paedophile problem
Tellonym	Anonymous messaging service	- Cyberbullying - Threats - Sexual Content - Unmonitored access - Inconsistent age restrictions
Bigu	Live-streaming platform	- No age verification needed - Users have to provide age & location - Bullying & Violence - Nudity - Inappropriate language
	Avatar-based social platform	- 18+ areas with nudity/sexual encounters - Sexual behaviour in non-age restricted areas - Chat features pairs random strangers - All profiles public - Bullying & Grooming
