<i>Clarity on Behaviour Incident Sanctions</i>	<i>A member requested clarity on whether all behaviour incidents recorded on the WEDUC Parent App results in an afterschool detention.</i>	<i>The Head of School clarified to parents and carers that all behaviour incidents do result in same-day afterschool detentions, except for non-completion of homework at Key Stage 3, where a specific trigger initiates the sanction.</i>
