## Arrival

- Pupils may arrive from 8.15am and should be in school no later than 8.40am.

## End of the Day

- The Transition Day will finish at 2.40pm.
- Pupils who are making their own way home will be dismissed first, followed by pupils being collected by a parent or carer. If you are collecting your child, please arrive by 2.40 pm.

## Food and Drink

- A morning snack and lunch will be provided for all pupils.
- If your child prefers to bring a packed lunch, they are welcome to do so.
- Please ensure your child also brings a named water bottle.

## Clothing

- Pupils should attend in their primary school uniform.
- There is no requirement to bring a PE kit for the Transition Day.

- Throughout the day, pupils will take part in a range of enjoyable activities designed to help them settle into school life. They will have the opportunity to:
  - Meet key members of staff;
  - Get to know their new classmates;
  - Become familiar with the school environment;
