<i>Attendance</i>	<i>A member commented that the wording of the attendance "nudge texts" could feel too firm and direct for some families.</i>	<i>We have reviewed the wording of our attendance "nudge texts" and updated them to provide a positive and supportive message aiming reinforce the importance of regular school attendance and working in partnership with families.</i>
<i>Enrichment</i>	<i>A member shared that the Cadets programme is highly valued by pupils and families and sought reassurance that it will continue.</i>	<i>We are delighted to confirm that the Cadets programme will continue into the new academic year. We are working hard to establish our own Cadet Contingent at the Turves Green Boys' School site, ensuring that more pupils can benefit from the valuable opportunities and experiences the programme provides.</i>
<i>School Day</i>	<i>A member welcomed the introduction of morning enrichment activities but highlighted the need to consider the practical arrangements for pupils and families.</i>	<i>We adapted our initial plans for the new school day based on parent forum feedback and are currently conducting a whole school parent and staff consultation, following approval of trustees. To support pupils in making a positive start to the day, all pupils will be offered a free breakfast from 8:00 am, with a range of nutritious options available. In addition, the school day has been adjusted, with the official start time moving to 9:00 am and the end of the school day to 3:30 pm. These changes will enable pupils to access a wider range of enrichment opportunities while supporting their wellbeing and readiness to learn.</i>
